A Register of Trees, Co. Cork, 1790-1860

Until the mid-eighteenth century there was little incentive for a tenant to plant trees on his leased land for the trees were legally the property of the landlord. However, between 1721 and 1765 by a series of parliamentary acts the tenant's position in this matter was progressively improved so that by the latter date he was entitled to all the trees he had planted, or their value, on the expiration of his lease. To prove his ownership it was necessary for him to register the trees, within a year of planting, with the clerk of the peace for the county. The registrations of trees planted was recorded at the quarter sessions, published in the *Government Gazette* and eventually entered in a ledger. These ledgers, entitled *A Register of Trees*, have survived for thirteen counties. That for Londonderry is in the Public Record Office, Northern Ireland, and those for Cavan, Cork, Kildare, Kilkenny, Limerick, Longford, Louth, Monaghan, Offaly, Sligo, Tipperary and Waterford are in the Public Record Office, Ireland. The information entered in these ledgers varies from county to county but that for Cork is extensive.* The entries are in chronological order and state the names of the tenant and landlord, the location of the plantation (usually the townland and parish), the date of registration and the number of each type of tree put in. It must be stressed that the information contained in these ledgers relates only to tenant planting, for a landlord had no need to prove possession of his trees.

Despite the inducements to plant offered by the 1765 act the increase in the number of plantations was slow and it was not until after 1800 or 1810 that planting got well under way. As will be seen, by the mid-nineteenth century the wave of planting was almost spent and after that time little was undertaken. In 1791 in Ireland as a whole a total of 105,100 acres had been planted by landlords and tenants. Fifty years later the figure had trebled to 345,200 acres. By then Cork was the best planted county with 52,000 acres, that is nearly 15% of the total acreage of plantations were in Cork. Galway came a poor second to Cork with about 7%. Unfortunately it is impossible to say what share of the plantations was owned by tenants, for the tenant registered the number of trees planted and not the acreage.

Cork tenants planted $9\frac{1}{2}$ million trees between 1790 and 1860 — $6\frac{1}{4}$ million conifers and $3\frac{1}{4}$ million hardwoods. Table 1 shows the total of both types of trees planted in consecutive decades and two important facts emerge: after 1810 conifers greatly outnumbered hardwoods in popularity and after 1840 comparatively little planting was carried out in comparison with the previous thirty years.

This decline in planting by tenants during or after the 1830s was a general phenomenon in Ireland; for example by 1840 in Londonderry 94% of nineteenth century tenant planting was accomplished, in Offaly 70%, in Sligo 89% and in Kildare 86%. There is no obvious single explanation of the drastic decline. In the British Isles by the 1830s supplies of timber from Canada were exceeding the demand, although it was not until 1860 when Canada lost her preferential tariff on timber that Baltic wood poured in. It has been suggested that the import of Canadian timber (and U.S.A. cotton) was linked to emigration — emigrants forming part of the return freight to America. There is also the factor of the declining agricultural economy in the years preceding the famine. Or it may be that the reason was simply that by 1840 it was generally felt that there had been sufficient planting for foreseeable domestic needs. Certainly between 1840 and 1880 planting balanced cutting, for the acreage under wood in Ireland was the same at the two dates.

When one turns to the upsurge in planting earlier in the century the reasons for it appears to be more obvious. Ireland had been steadily denuded of timber since 1600 and with an increasing population demand for it was increasing. From the mid-eighteenth century onwards more and more emphasis was laid on the need to build up a domestic stock of what was then an absolutely basic commodity. The difficulties of shipping during the Napoleonic wars highlighted the growing dependence on foreign wood even in Britain which was much more wooded than Ireland. There was also in Ireland, as in Britain, a growing desire to embellish and beautify, and what more becoming to a house than a fine avenue of trees? The Big House had had its plantations for two or three generations. It is clear from the evidence of the Registers of Trees that there was by the early nineteenth century a tenant class of sufficient substance to follow the landlord's example.

A large proportion of tenant planters made more than one registration. The number of Cork registrations is given in table 2 and they reflect the pattern already observed in the number of trees planted — a sharp increase early in the nineteenth century and an equally sharp fall after the end of the 1830s.

As has already been indicated there was a rapid increase in the number of conifers planted after the end of the eighteenth century. The three most consequential species were European larch, Scots pine and Norway spruce. The three North American conifers, Sitka spruce, Douglas Fir and *Pinus contorta* which make up 90% of today's state plantations, had not then been introduced into Europe. Larch and Norway spruce have retained their position as an acceptable species, but Scots pine, except under special conditions, has not. Neither has Silver fir. By 1860 there was also a total of 128,500 trees planted in Cork which had been simply designated as 'fir' and about 20,500 in all of Balm of Gilead fir, pinaster, Weymouth pine, yew, cedar, Austrian pine, cypress, stone pine and juniper.

Such was the popularity of larch, introduced from Central Europe into the British Isles about the sixteenth century, and first grown on a large scale by the Duke of Atholl on his estates in Scotland in the second half of the eighteenth century, that it formed a third of all the trees planted by Cork tenants. Larch was king.

There was a larger range of hardwood species put in although no hardwood was planted in such numbers as the conifers. Ash was the favourite, closely followed by beech and oak, between them accounting for 2 million trees. Alder topped the half million, and sycamore and elm between them numbered another half million.

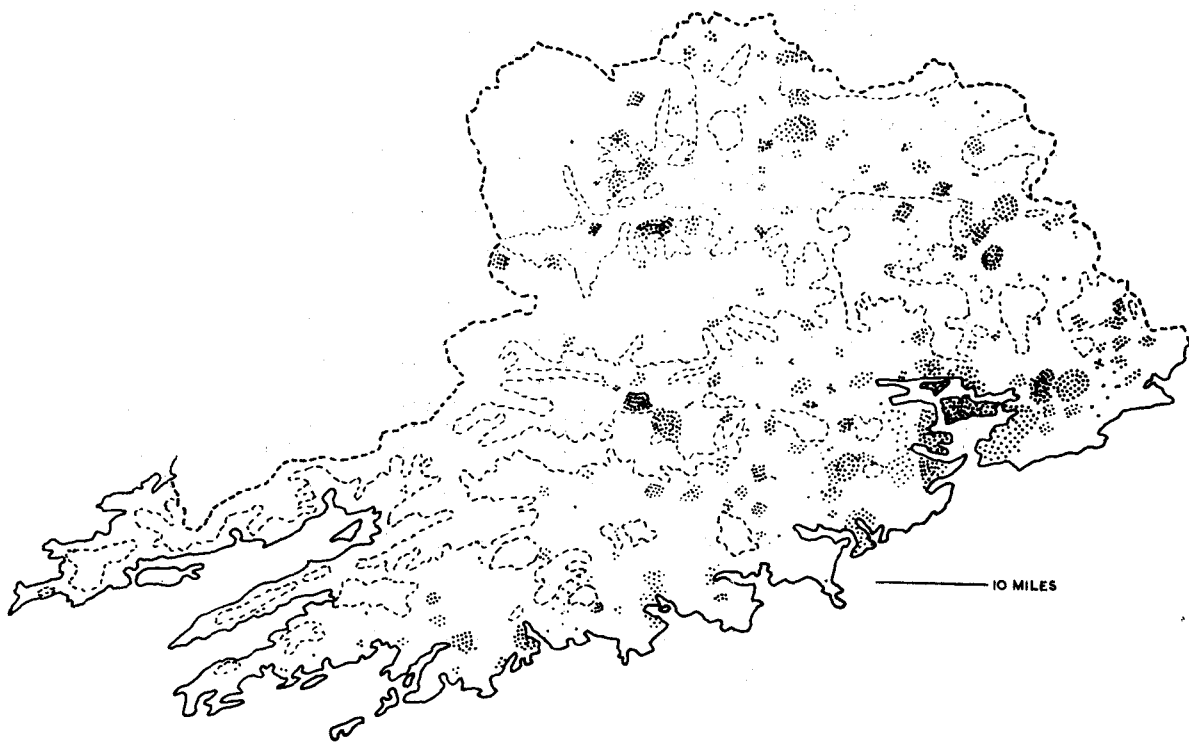

As has been found in the case of the other counties whose Tree Registers have been analysed, more than half the tenant planters put in under 5,000 trees and in Cork four out of five put in less than 10,000. Planting followed a different pattern from present day state planting. There was, of course, some block planting but the emphasis was on shelter belts along the sides of fields, avenues and domestic embellishments and hedgerow planting. There were 2½ million hedgerow trees in Cork in 1841. This pattern of planting is well illustrated by the following abstract from the registration made by John Leader in October 1813 of his planting in Lower Keal, Cullen parish. '156 fir in ditch south of road near Blackwater Bridge. 56 fir on ditch north of said road and opposite the above ditch. 220 fir in ditch north of road leading to Garrane near the little bridge. 134 alder on ditch between the big meadow and bog near Garrane. 200 alder between the course meadow and the above bog on a ditch. 785 trees in north east Corse and east of Inch bounding Garrane. 300 oak in the same place and mixed with the fir and 30 alder. 800 fir on south west corner of Inch on bank of Blackwater river. 520 oak in same place mixed with fir. 32 alders same place. 60 fir on east side of Big Meadow and 78 alder same place'.

The remnants of the early nineteenth century planting that survived the holocaust of timber attendant on Gladstone's land acts of the 1880s can be seen now as mature and aging trees in the roadside hedges, the field hedges and in decaying avenues. The landscape created five or six generations ago is a full-blown rose with petals fully expanded and falling. There will be a landscape six generations hence, but it will not be the landscape of today.

From the map in the text it can be seen that the area of most dense planting lay in a semi-circle stretching from Kinsale to Cork to Castlemartyr. The rest of the planting was for the most part round the south coast estuaries, in the valley south of Macroom, the lowlands of East Cork around Fermoy and, more patchily, in North Cork on the lowland between Doneraile and Kanturk. West of the latitude of Skibbereen planting was virtually non-existent. In terms of parishes Ballymartle (236,000), Ballyoughtera (208,000), Castlelyons (330,000), Clonmeen (208,000), Middletown (254,000), Tracton (217,000), Kilmurry (222,000) and Kilquane (402,000) accounted for a quarter of all tenant planting, leaving the rest to be spread over 161 other parishes. In the same manner the number of 'big' planters was limited, nine tenants putting in over 100,000 trees. These were: Benjamin Clarke Fisher, 402,000 in Kilquane; Achilles Daunt, 188,000 in Tracton; George Grehan Rutland, 183,000 in Doneraile; Thomas Wigmore 145,000 in Middletown; Charles Beamish 137,000 in Dunisky; Rev. John Stayle 128,000 in Ballymartle; Thomas Richard Going, 118,000 in Ballyoughtera; John Harold Barry, 115,000 in Doneraile and Michael Creagh, 107,000 in Doneraile. These nine men, by then contemporary standards, were planters on a commercial scale, and accounted for about 14% of all tenant plantings. They favoured conifers and planted them in the ratio of 4 conifers to 1 hardwood. Fisher, who planted more trees than any other tenant, included only 10,000 deciduous trees in his total of 402,000.

The list that follows is a synopsis of the information contained in the 1,218 registrations (except for the name of the landlord) grouped according to parish. The figure to the right of the parish name is the total for that parish. The date is the year of the registration and is followed by the number of trees planted to the nearest ten. The placenames are given in modern spelling where identification has been possible (that is in about four-fifths of cases) but names of tenants have been left in the original spelling.
